His research focuses on the intersection of Semiotics, Language, and Computer Science. His principal contribution, developed in collaboration with Dr. Gloria López Ramos, is the formulation of a linguistic theory called Semiotax, which centers on the sentence and provides an innovative analysis aimed at constructing a sentence algorithm and its universal equation.
